- they need fish: fresh, frozen, saltwater, freshwater, it doesn't matter.
- need volunteers to be available on call to bring animals to them when folks from the outskirts of the area call in with rescued critters.
- need financial support; all donations are accepted.
- need mealworms.
- took in about 600 critters this past year.
- big project near term is to build huge Flight Tent for Raptors, 12x12x50, cost \$12K.

**And thanks to Big George Goehring for his MEDICAL MOMENT on TUBERCULOSIS:** If you have a question about exposure to TB get tested or see your physician. The test for TB is a PPD skin test which when positive will be greater than 10 mm red raised circle after 72 hours. If you just tested negative with a skin test for TB you should get retested in 12 months because there is an incubation period where the test will give a false negative. Even if you test positive for TB it only means you have been exposed to the bacilli's bacteria that causes TB it DOES NOT MEAN THAT YOU HAVE THE DISEASE. TB is making a come back in the US, but there are still drugs that will treat the disease.

- Symptoms include a frequent dry cough with possible blood tinged mucous, low grade fever and night sweats. Usually affects people with a compromised immune system. There are no vaccinations to prevent the disease. Transmission is generally from contact with the saliva from infected individuals and the disease primarily attacks the lungs, but can affect other parts of the body like the bones as well.
