### A HUGE THANKS to T.300 ASM John Duval for his Patrol Science Experiment on Roller Coasters 'R' Us.

John gave an excellent slide show presentation on Science and its relationship to Scouting that included many great quotes (per Ernest Rutherford, "If your experiment needs statistics, you ought to have done a better experiment."). He also

applied the scientific method to a Scout campout. Also, remember to translate your hypothesis into something that is measureable, answering only 1 question with True or False. Then John outlined an experiment and provided the necessary "tools" to build a roller coaster, with some height and several loops, and being able to roll BBs, marbles, and steelies into a cup thus scoring points. The RT crowd broke up into 3 Patrols to work the experiment in 15 minutes and everyone had a great time and each Patrol was successful. The results were:

**Patrol #1 – Larry Dawson reported 8 points scored.**

**Patrol #2 – Alan Holt reported 21 points scored.**

**Patrol #3 – Joe Dippin reported 24 points scored.**
