**When:** Saturday, March 26, 2011, 8:00 AM to 3:00 PM

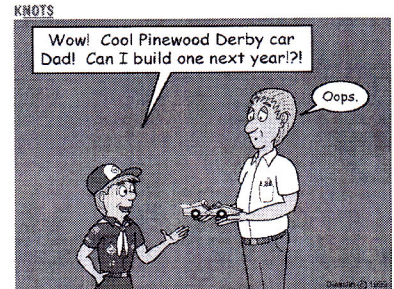

### Awards:

1st, 2nd, 3rd Place, Sportsmanship, various design awards for each group .  
1st, 2nd, 3rd Places, and possibly others for finals.

### Registration:

For all racers registration is \$5.

### Who Can Race:

- All Finalists (1st, 2nd, and 3rd place) in each pack division will be eligible to compete in the District Finals starting at their division level. Packs may send alternates if a scout cannot attend.
- Scouts, friends, families are invited to enter the youth and adult open classes.
- Scouts racing in the Finals cannot register for the open classes.
- Webelos 2's who have crossed over to Boy Scouts in the 2010-2011 school year are eligible to race in the Webelo division.

The Scouts and adults should make the car together as a project! It is not the intent that the adult show the Scout the garage door then walk away; nor is it the intent that the boy play video games while the adult cuts and sands. Adults should shape with the power tools and then direct the rest of the action while showing the Scout each step in building a car. Every year, the Scout should do more and more of their own car work as they learn and grow.
